## Gender balance of staff presenting at SMG and Assembly Commission meetings and at Assembly Community Connect Sessions

1 Introduction
This Briefing Note presents the latest available statistics on the gender balance of staff presenting at Secretariat Management Group meetings, Northern Ireland Assembly Commission meetings (2016/17) and at Assembly Community Connect sessions (2016). This information will inform the work of the Northern Ireland Assembly Secretariat's Gender Action Implementation Group. When drawing conclusions from the data, it is important to bear in mind that individual members of staff may have presented more than once over the time period in question. It is also important to note that in many instances presenters will have been selected due to their role.

## 2 Gender balance at Secretariat Management Group

For the period 2016/17, staff deputised at SMG meetings on five occasions. Of these, a female deputised on one occasion while males deputised on four occasions (see Table 1).

Over the same period, 61 presentations were made to SMG by staff -32 by female members of staff ( $52 \%$ ) and 29 by male members of staff ( $48 \%$ ). Although some members of staff made more than one presentation and in many instances staff are selected to present due to their role e.g. the Head of HR, it is noteworthy that females represent approximately $44 \%$ of all staff. The highest proportion of presentations were by females at grade 5 while the highest proportion of presentations were by males at grade 3. No females at grades 6 and 7 presented to SMG while six presentations to SMG were by males at grade 6 (14\%) and grade 7 ( $7 \%$ ).

## 3 Gender balance at Northern Ireland Assembly Commission meetings

For the period 2016/17, one presentation was by a female member of staff and four presentations were by male members of staff.

## 4 Gender balance at Assembly Community Connect sessions

In 2016, there were 42 Assembly Community Connect sessions. The gender of the presenters was recorded in 29 of these. Based on the data available, $48.3 \%(n=43)$ of presenters were female and $51.7 \%$ were male ( $n=46$ ).
