B E IT ENACTED by being passed by the Northern Ireland Assembly and assented to by Her Majesty as follows:

Curriculum, minimum content: CPR and AED

1. After Article 7 of the Education (Northern Ireland) Order 2006 (minimum content) insert—

"Minimum content: CPR and AED

- 7A. The Department must exercise its powers under Article 7(2), to ensure that, in relation to the area of learning called Learning for life and work, in relation to key stage 3, the minimum content includes—
 - (a) training in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), and
 - (b) automatic external defibrillator (AED) awareness.".

2. This Act comes into operation after the end of the period of three months beginning with the date on which it receives Royal Assent.
