








Dynamics of decision-making 1= not at all; 7 = to a large extent












Citizens using the Internet to interact with public authorities by age group (2012)
















Changing employment patterns







Structural re-organisation












Existing agencies – 21 states (mainly EU)







Public organisations in Rol: 1922-2012




