The Committee for the Economy considered your memo of the 16th November, regarding the above Bill, at its meeting on 18th November.

Members agreed that I should undertake a brief canvass of relevant stakeholders' views on the Bill and bring this information back to the Committee at a subsequent meeting.

At its meeting of 2nd December, the Committee agreed to respond as set out below.

The stakeholders canvassed indicated that they are broadly in support of the provisions of the Bill, as is the Committee. Respondents suggested that the Bill charts a sensible course between tackling alcohol misuse and promoting responsible consumption, and introducing measures that will support businesses in the tourism and hospitality sectors.

As this only provides a general overview of stakeholders' thoughts, they have been advised to respond to the Committee for Communities' call for evidence in more detail.
