I am absolutely opposed to the "Abortion Services Bill". It would make law-breakers out of sincere, well-meaning people who seek to express a deeply held conviction in the hope that they may persuade others of it. Those opposed to this attempt at persuasion, should themselves use persuasion (not criminalisation) as their method to stop it. In any case where intimidation or harassment is carried out by individuals at abortion clinics, the appropriate legislation will already apply, and offenders will receive the due penalty. Please consider the fact that persuasion is not intimidation, nor is it harassment.
