"Abortion Services (Safe Access Zones) Bill" that was introduced in the Assembly by Clare Bailey in September. The purpose of the Bill is I informed to criminalise any pro-life activity around abortion centres in Northern Ireland.

I see this as a breach of human rights, against respectful and peaceful protest to protect the life of an unborn child, and to protect vulnerable mothers. Having known 2 women who completely regretted having an abortion and who would not have done so only they were unsupported; this bill would take away and deny them from finding out about sources of help and alternatives to their situation.

As a society we should not be encouraging the deliberate killing of unborn children, who are precious and necessary for the common good. By the end of this century, we will experience a financial and societal collapse due to a deficit in the population caused by falling birth rates - all research on this on online and based on fact, we will have a huge lack of workers to pay tax and look after an aging population. Therefore, this law is in no way contributing to the common good for which we elect elected representatives to work for.

This bill is trying to normalise a medical procedure which murders an individual who could contribute to society- it is most definitely not in the common good to pass it
