Subject: REVIEW OF LEGISLATIVE CONSENT MOTIONS

You will recall that in March 2020, I wrote to all statutory committee Clerks to inform you that the Committee on Procedures was undertaking a review of the current procedures for Legislative Consent Motions and the relating Standing Order (42A) and to seek your Committee's views on a number of issues.

Subsequently, in April 2020, I informed you that, as a result of the Covid-19 pandemic, the Committee agreed to postpone its review.

Given that the Assembly business has recently resumed a more normal routine, the Committee agreed to recommence its review and to seek the views of your Committee on the current procedures for Legislative Consent Motions.

As a reminder, the issues the Committee are keen to consider in its review are:

- a) review the circumstances in which use of a Legislative Consent Motion is considered appropriate;
- b) review the processes through which Legislative Consent Motions are introduced to the Assembly;
- review the mechanisms by which the Assembly specifically gives, or does not give, its consent;

- d) review the arrangements for consultation with and consideration and reporting by committees of the proposed legislation and its outworkings;
- e) to consider the need to introduce a Standing Order/amendments to Standing Orders to address the issues identified within the inquiry.
