Linda, a chara,

Thank you for your letter of 23RD September 2020 in relation to the issue of members' statements. There are, of course, already a range of Assembly process that allow members to raise and put issues on the record in the Assembly Chamber. There does not seem to be any urgent reason to add to these and given the current pressures on Assembly time because of the COVID-19 crisis, Sinn Féin does not believe that this is an appropriate time to consider adding to existing Assembly arrangements and processes.

This is, however, an issue we could return to for further discussion and consideration at some point in the future as we return, hopefully, to some type of normality. We would want to see a very clear rationale and argument for any changes to Standing Orders, including a review of processed and procedures in other Legislatures. None of this could be viewed as a priority in the current context.
