The following is my response to the Bill of Rights Consultation.

As a Northern Irish citizen I support that rights be protected for every human being and therefore want you please to include the protection of rights for every pre-born child.

I have personal experience of abortion. After I was raped, at the age of 13, I was coerced by my parents into having my child removed by suction at a clinic in Liverpool. I was unable to grieve the loss of my child that lead to me experiencing post traumatic stress disorder (post-abortion trauma). For the 12+ weeks I was carrying my child, Michael, he had his own DNA, not my DNA, and scientifically he was a completely different and separate human being to me. I believe from the research that I've read that my son suffered pain during the procedure.

The human rights of pre-born babies needs to be carefully considered, along with scientific facts, when including provision for them in this Bill.

I look forward to hearing that you've received this letter and that my response will be considered along with the completed surveys you've received.
