1 Apologies

1.1 Apologies were received from John Stewart.

2 Minutes of previous meeting

2.1 The minutes of the meeting on 20 April were **agreed**.

3 Matters Arising

- 3.1 The Speaker drew Members' attention to a memo he had sent to the Committee outlining proposals to manage timed debates in plenary, explained his proposals in more detail and answered Members' questions.
- 3.2 Following discussion, Members **agreed** to adopt the Speaker's proposals, on a trial basis until the summer recess with regular monitoring, for:
 - i. An additional 15 minutes to be added to a fixed time debate if an amendment is selected, with a further 15 minutes for each additional amendment. Adjusted timings will be shown on indicative timings in advance.
 - ii. A discretionary 10-15 minute 'grace period' to be added to the end of a fixed time debate to help broaden the scope of debate or range of participants. It will be used at the Chair's discretion taking into account the circumstances of a specific debate and will not be notified to Members in advance.
- 3.3 Members **noted** that it remained the case that it would not be in order to challenge the Chair's decision on whether or how to exercise the 'grace period'.
- 3.4 There were no other matters arising.

4.1 Members **noted** that there would be no sitting on Monday 3 May due to the public holiday.
