- To ask the Department for further information on what measures are in place to ensure vulnerable students of Further Education colleges receive support.
- To ask the Department for further information regarding the status of employees in the vulnerable category and statutory sick pay.

*Agreed*: the Committee agreed, in principle, Clauses 7 and 8 and Schedule 6 of the Coronavirus Bill.
