# **3.** Oral Briefing from Further Education Colleges - The impact of results 2020 & the safe reopening of campuses

Key issues discussed included: recognition of work of FE staff to successfully facilitate remote learning for students, status of apprenticeships by sector, current challenges in FE enrolment, Departmental led incentives available to employers for training and apprenticeships, effects of furloughing by businesses on apprenticeship schemes and awarding of qualifications, health and safety guidance for staff and students on return to campus post lockdown, the high number of qualifications, and BTEC service.

*Agreed:* to write to Mr Webb, in his capacity as Chair of Principals' Group, seeking that he collate feedback on BTEC from colleges.
