

WESTMINSTER FINANCE BILL

Thank you for your letter of 3 December in which you requested further information on the content of the Finance (Taxation) Bill and its implications for Northern Ireland.

The Bill gained Royal Assent on 17 December 2020 and passed onto the statute book as the Taxation (Post-transition Period) Act 2020. During its progress through Parliament the Executive was not consulted, and therefore we are unable to provide the Committee with the information requested.
