The Commissioners guidance on NICS Code of Ethics Guidance for Appellants (May 2013) states, "Your wish to appeal should be communicated to Commissioners within three months of the date of the matter of concern taking place, or, if you have raised the concern through the internal procedures, within three months of the date on which you received a final written response from your department to the concern raised."
