I write to express my support for the “Severe Foetal Impairment Abortion (amendment) Bill” which is before Stormont at present. I wish to express my view that the current abortion law is discriminatory. It means that an unborn baby deemed to have a disability does not have the same legal protection as other babies. If this amendment is defeated it means that people living with disabilities will be led to believe that their lives are less valuable than others.
