The real inquiry should be into why LISNASKEA HIGH SCHOOL was closed when it was already doing a 3 year partnership with other ccms schools in the area. This is so sad now when it is going to be made mainstreamed. It is definitely a good idea, it is a good chance for all children getting a chance to learn together.

My daughter was at Lisnaskea High when it closed last year, she decided to go to an integrated school, and total loves it. It is well organised and there is no fuss made by different religions. All are treated equal, which is the way it should be,
