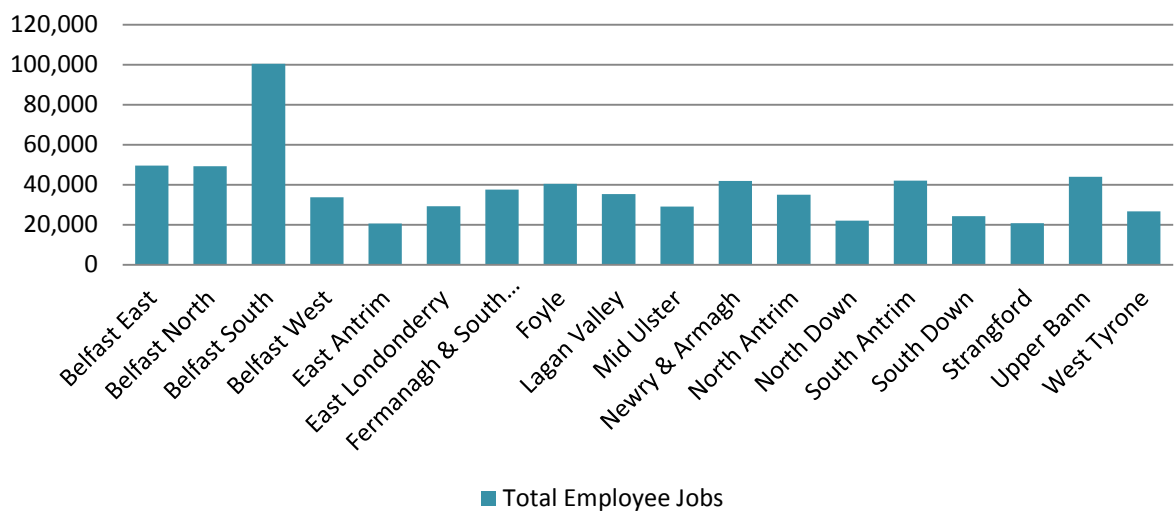

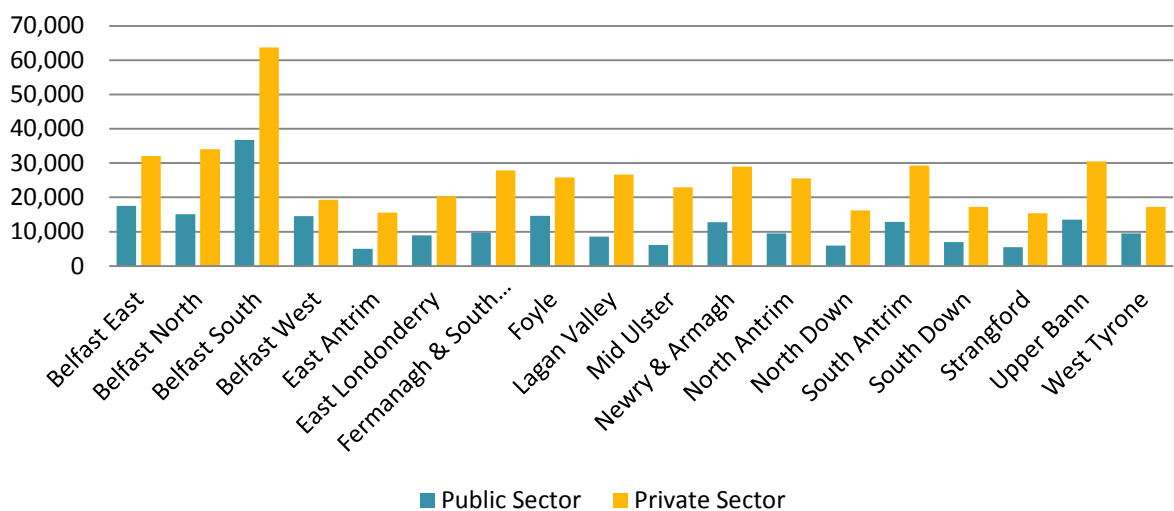

Figure 1: Total Employee Jobs September 2011



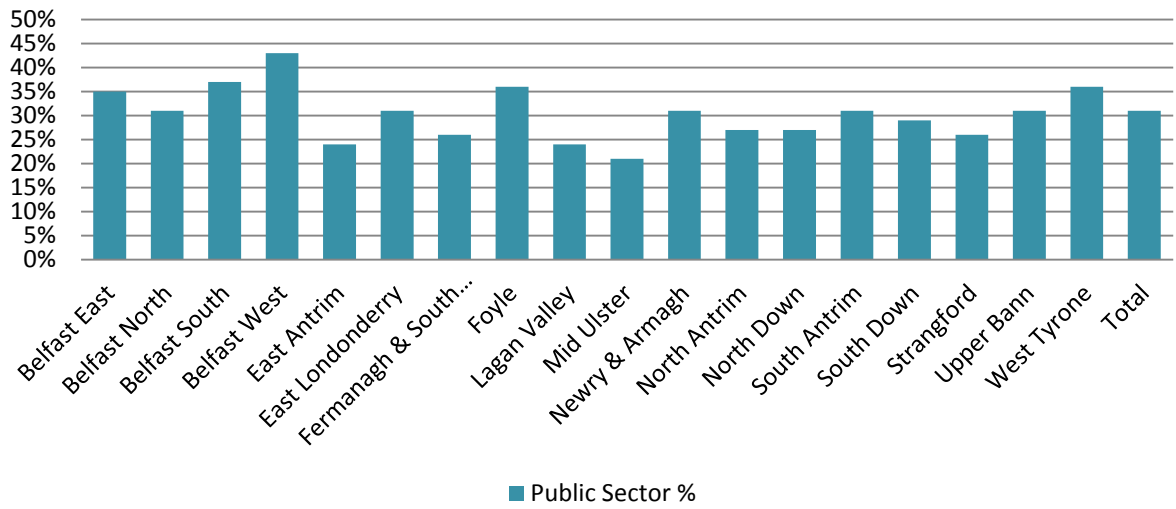

Figure 4: Labour Force Survey – Employment Rate 16+ 2012

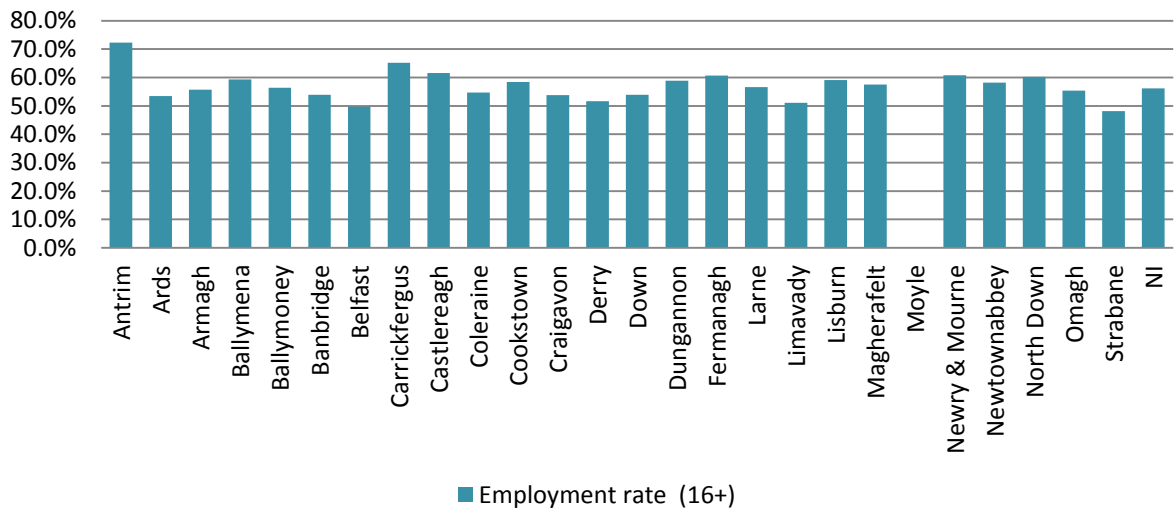
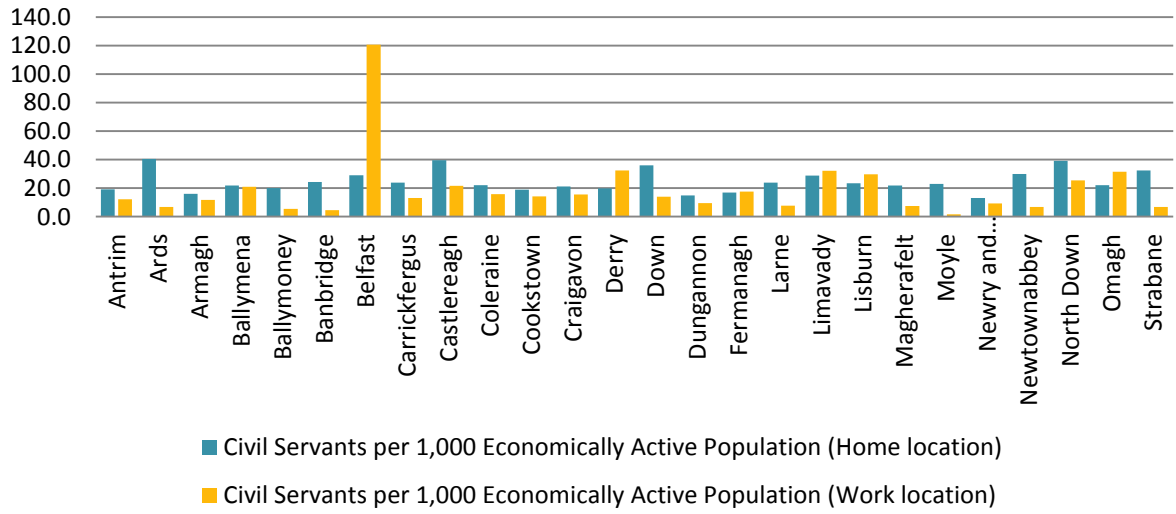


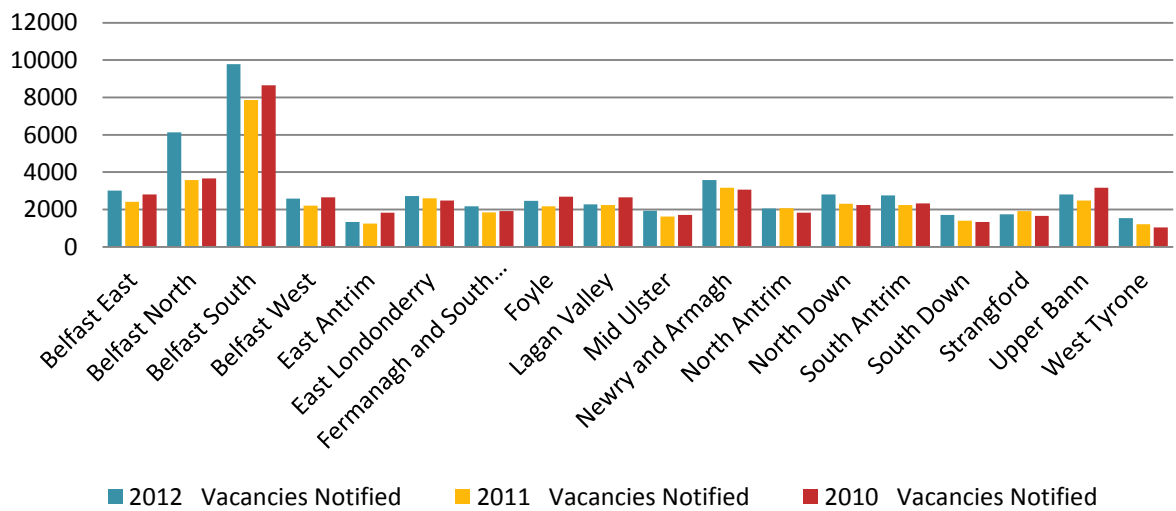
Figure 5: Civil Servants per 1,000 Economically Active Population Home and Work location

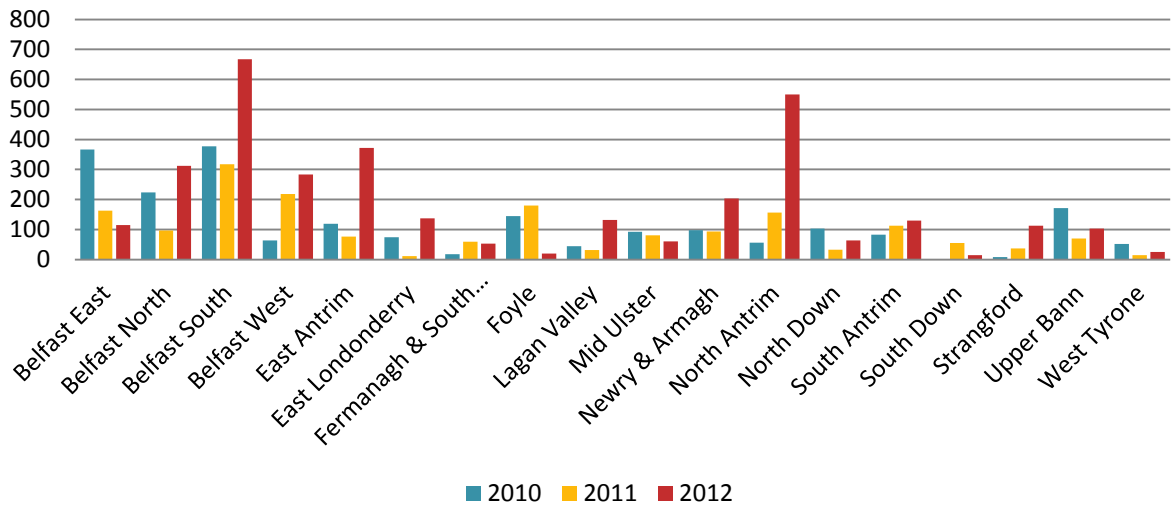
Figure 6: Vacancies notified to Job Centres/Jobs and Benefits Offices 2010 - 2012

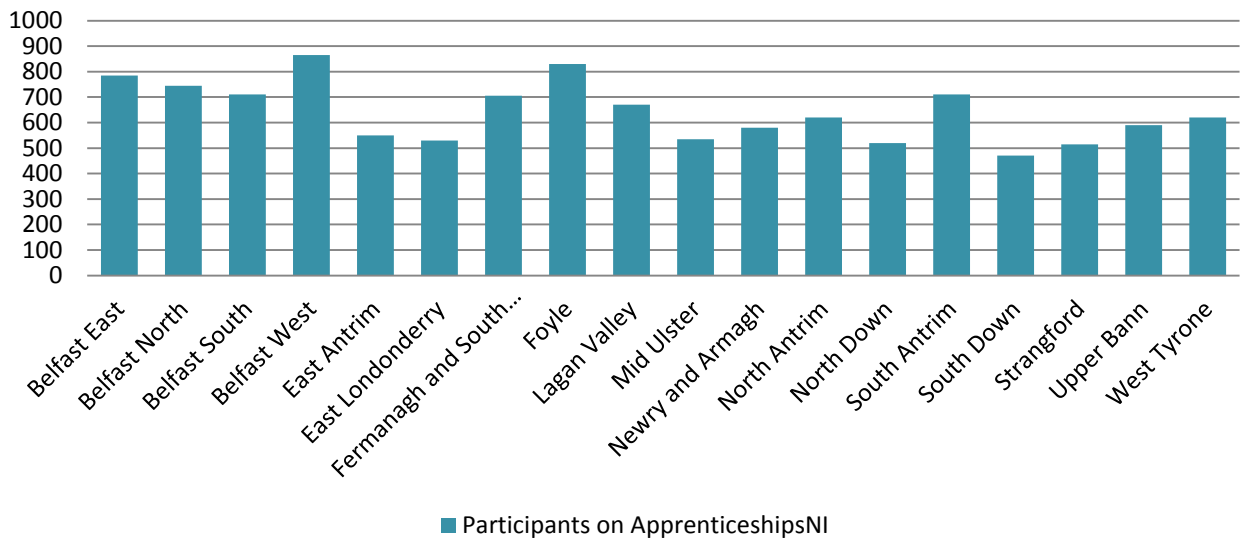
Figure 7: Confirmed Redundancies by Parliamentary Constituency 2010 – 2012

Figure 9: Economically inactive

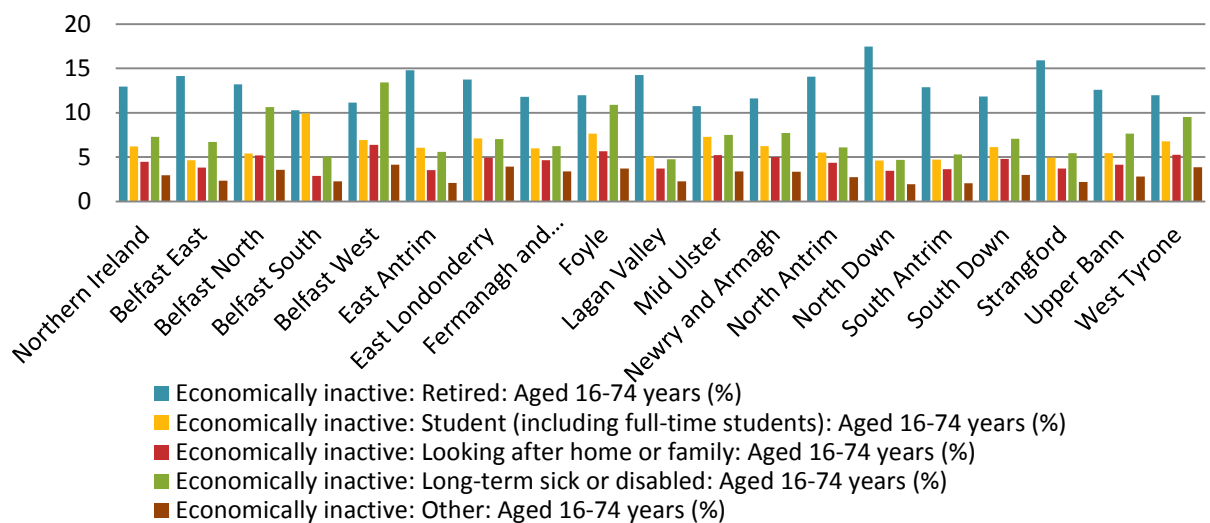
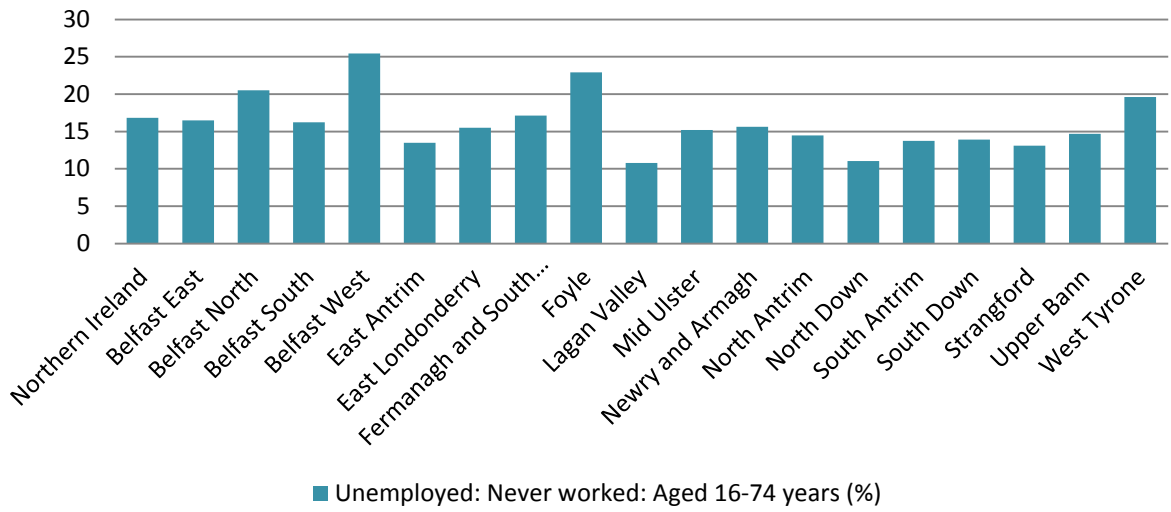


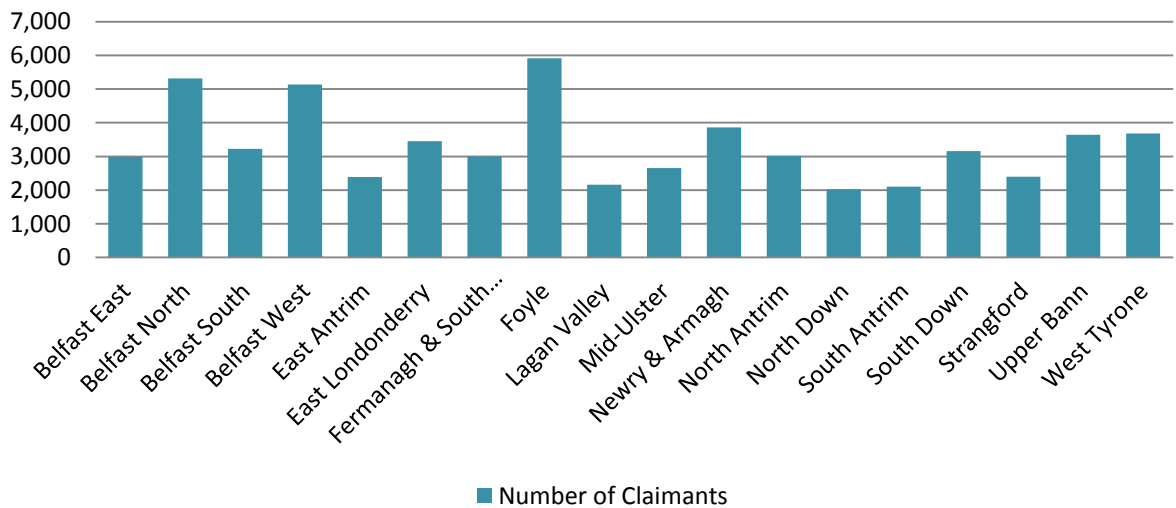
Figure 10: Percentage Unemployed – never worked

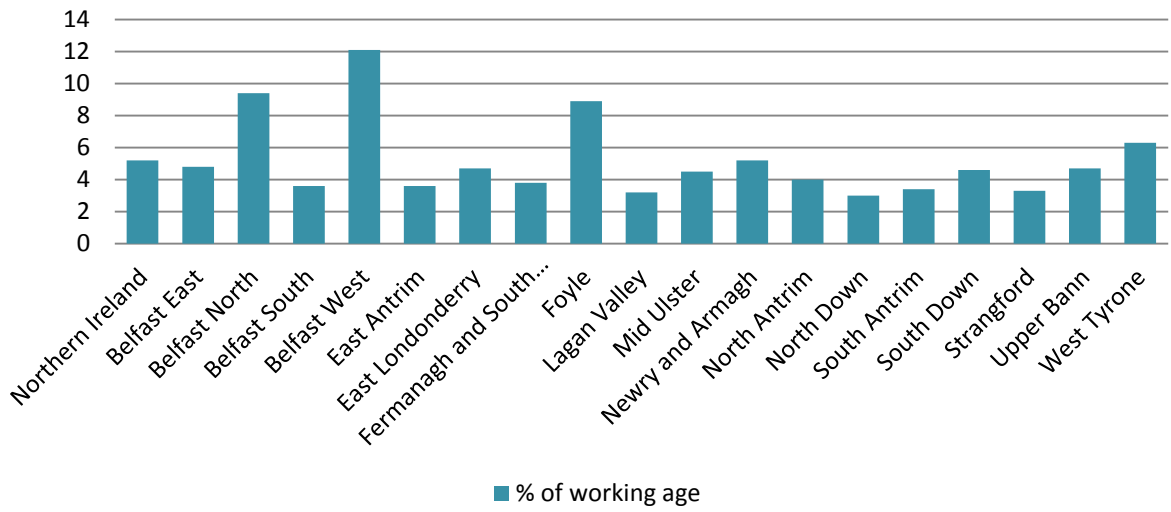

Figure 11: Claimant count October 2013



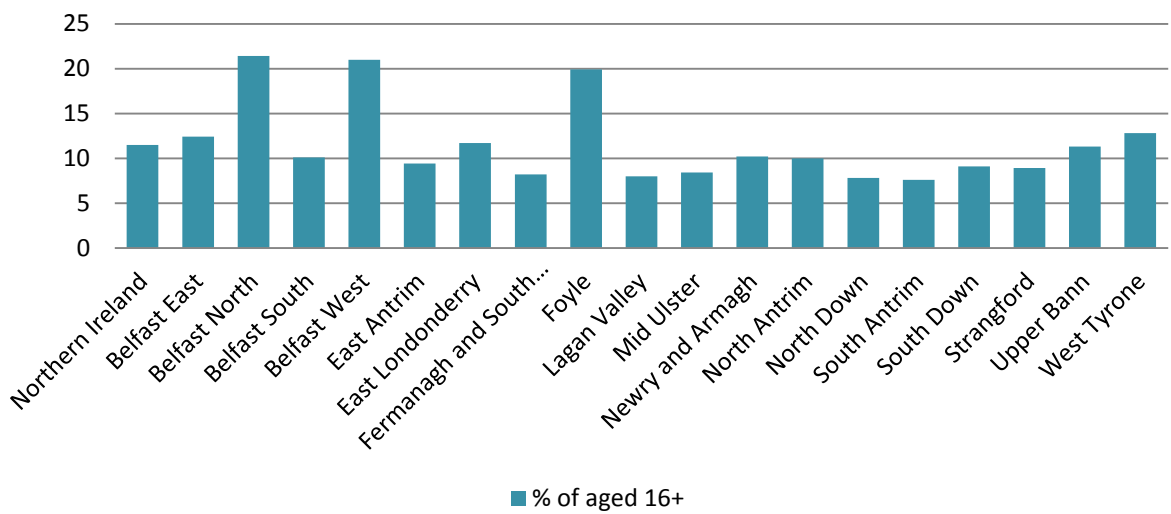

Figure 12: Percentage of working population receiving income support February 2013



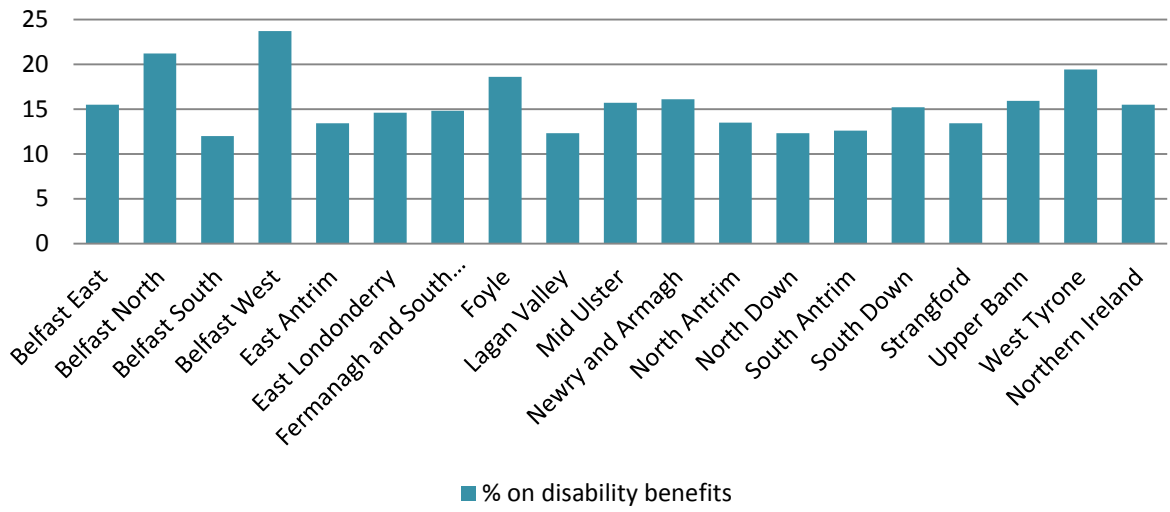

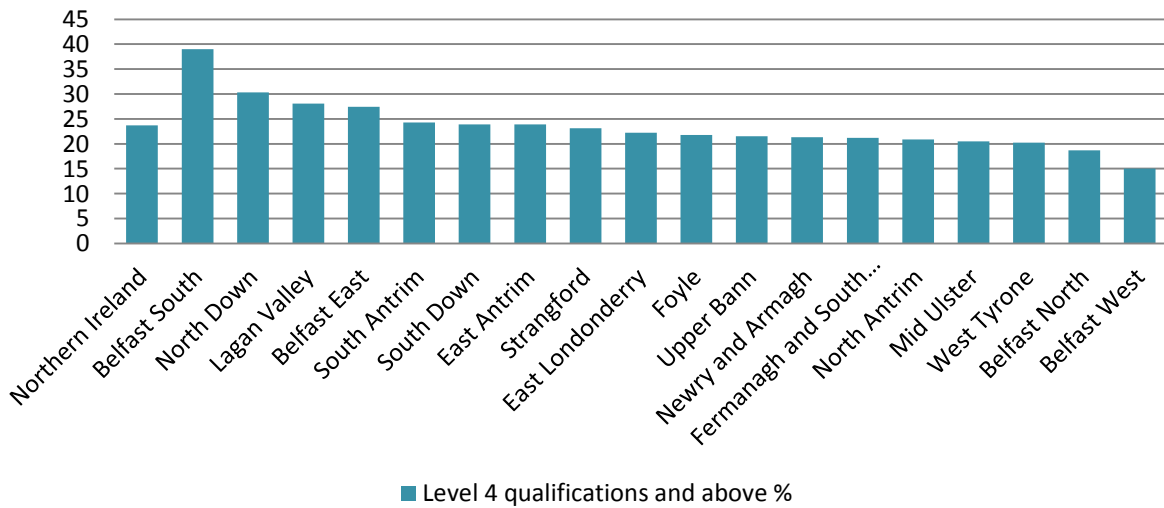
Figure 13: Percentage of population receiving disability benefits February 2013

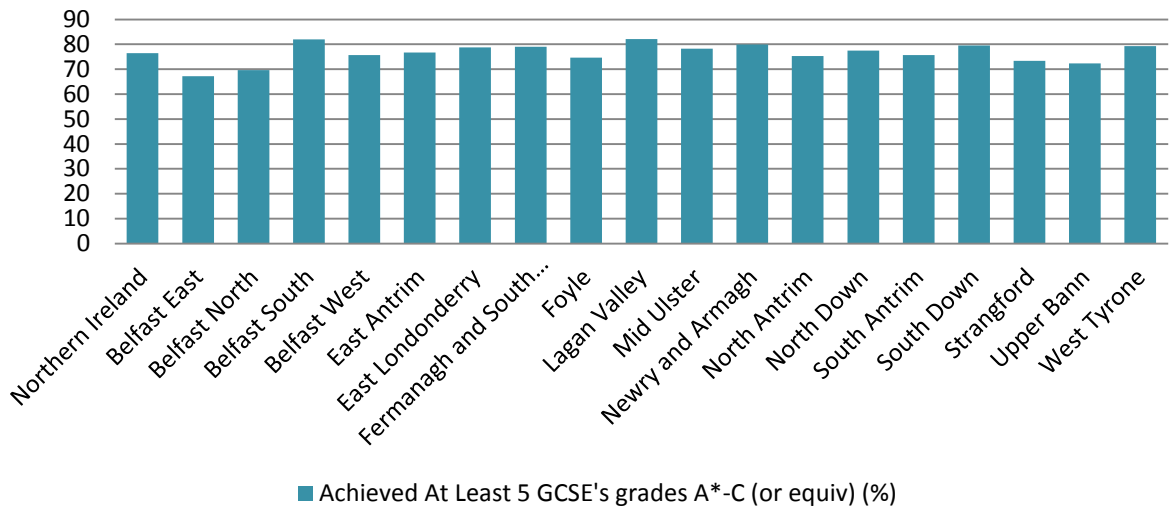

Figure 14: Percentage of residents ages 16+ with qualifications level 4 qualifications and above



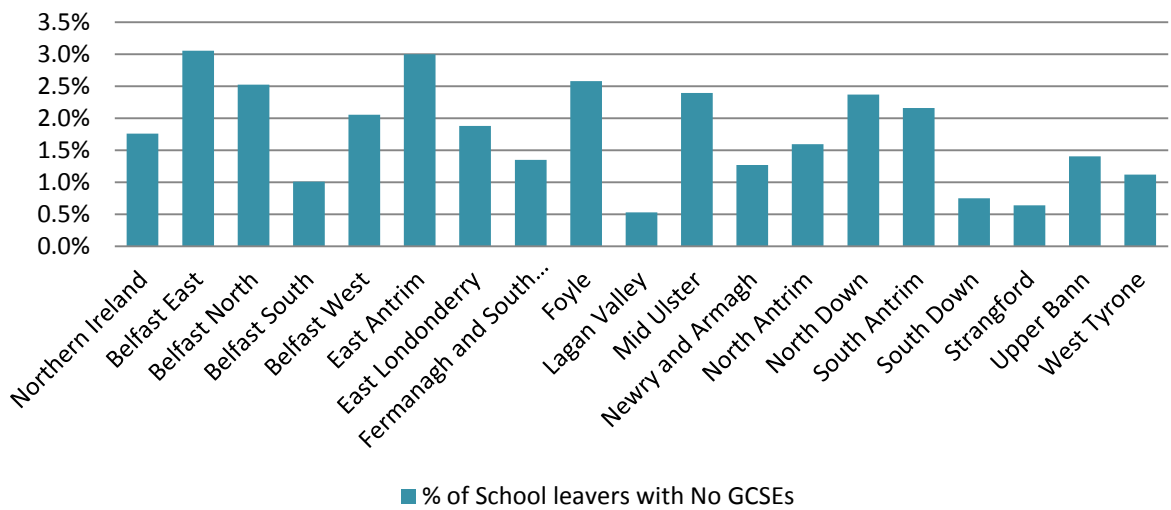

Figure 15: Percentage of school leavers achieving 5 GCSE's grades A*-C



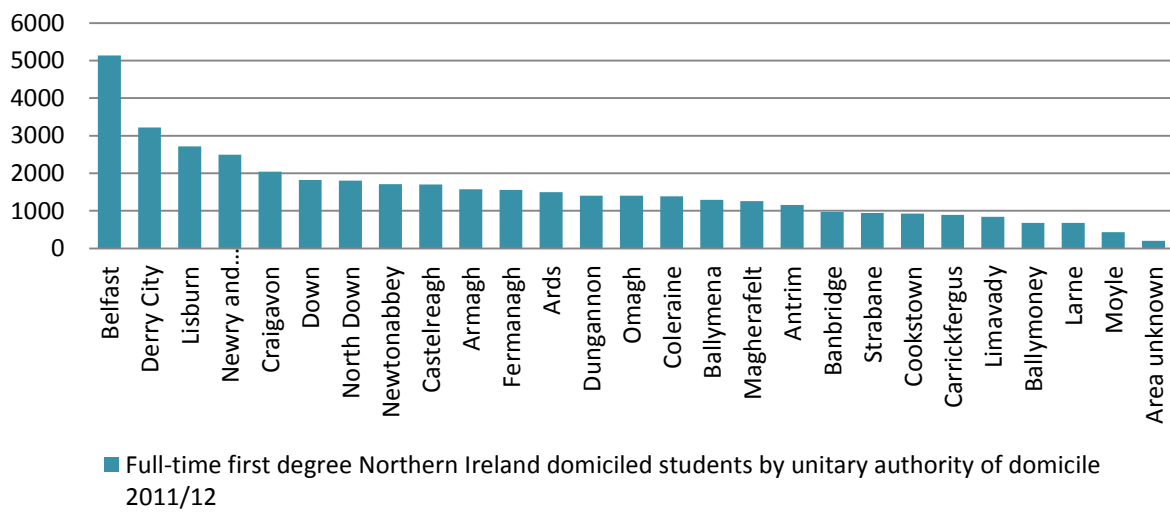

Figure 18: Northern Ireland NEET Rate by NUTs3 region 2011

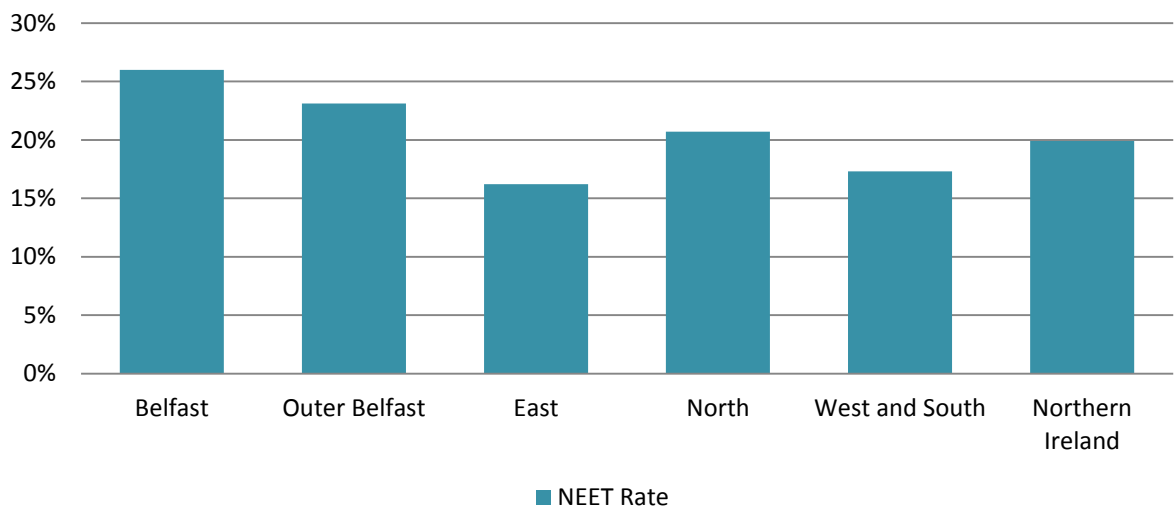
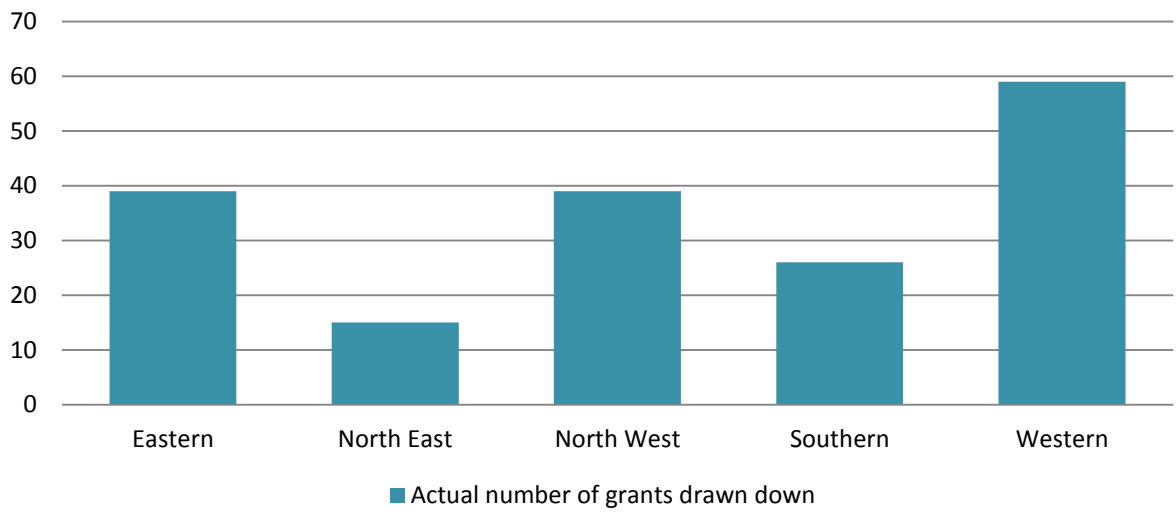
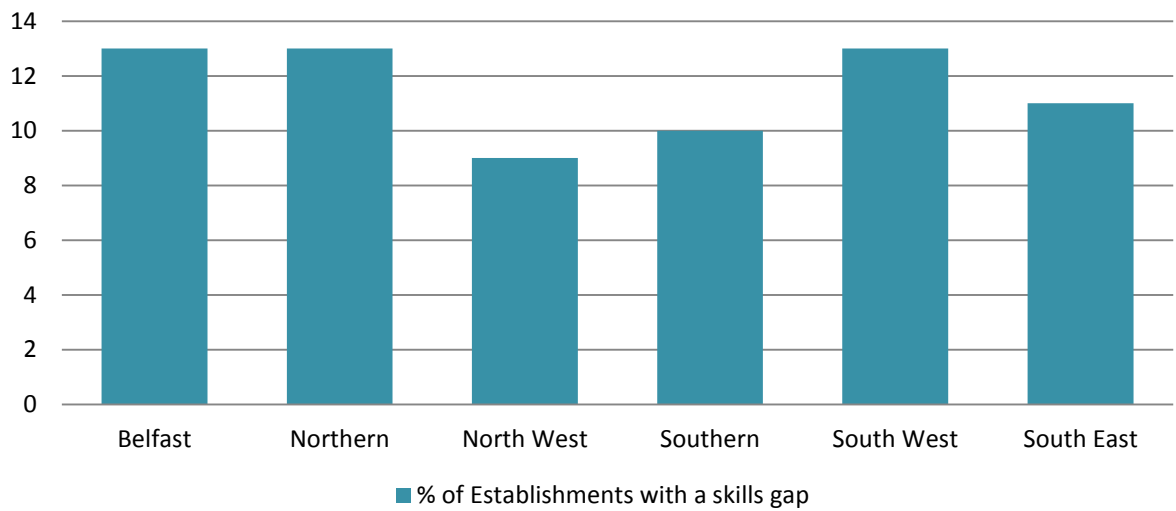


Figure 19: Actual draw down of Enterprise Northern Ireland NEETS grants up to May 2013



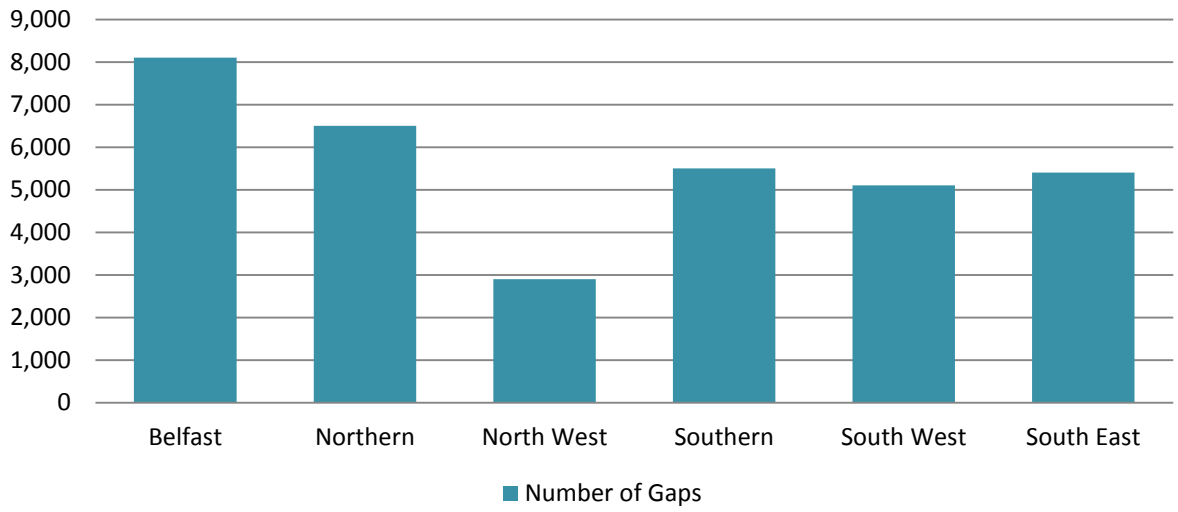

Figure 20: Percentage of establishments reporting skills gaps



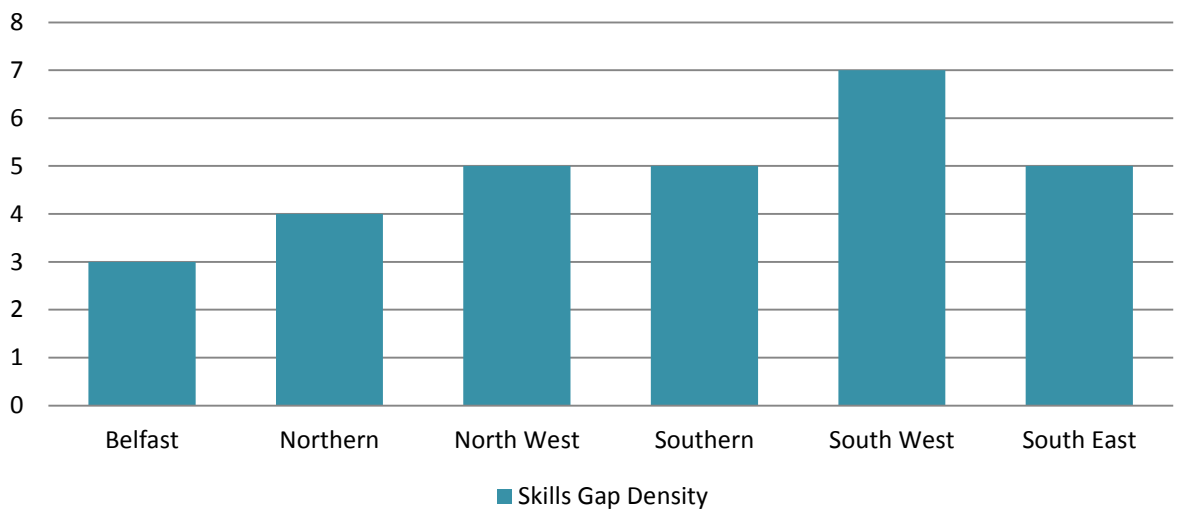
