

GDHI at current basic prices (£m)




Figure 2: NUTs 3 GDHI per capita Northern Ireland (£) 2011

Figure 3: Income Thresholds – Percentage of individuals in low-income groups by Local Government District, before housing costs





Figure 4: Income Thresholds – Percentage of individuals in low-income groups by Local Government District after housing costs





Figure 5: Weekly pay - Gross (£) - For all employee jobs: Northern Ireland 2012








Figure 7: Percentage households at specific social grades






Figure 8: Type of housing tenure








Figure 10: Average capital values of domestic properties 2012






Figure 11: Average rates bill 2011/12 & 2012/13

- Households: Oil central heating (%)




Figure 13: Percentage of households with no central heating
