Dear Ms Frazer,

Your correspondence of 29 July 2015 refers.

As advised by the NAMA Chairman in his correspondence to the Finance and Personnel Committee (the "Committee") of 9 July, NAMA must decline the Committee's invitation to appear before it for the reasons outlined in that correspondence. However, as also indicated in that correspondence, NAMA is happy to assist the work of the Committee in so far as it can. In this respect, should the Committee wish to put written questions to NAMA that were not raised at the Dáil Public Accounts Committee meeting of 9 July, NAMA will endeavour to provide written responses subject to NAMA having knowledge of the matters concerned and subject to any legal constraints which may apply.

As already advised, in so far as there was alleged wrongdoing at the periphery of the Project Eagle transaction in Northern Ireland on the part of certain individuals who had no relationship with NAMA on this transaction, we are not in a position to comment as we have no knowledge of what may have taken place within a third party law firm and it is entirely and appropriately a matter for the Northern Ireland authorities to investigate.
