2. Matters Arising

The Committee noted a letter from the Department of Justice outlining its intention to postpone a proposed public consultation on three draft Codes of Practice for Northern Ireland relating to the Proceeds of Crime Act 2002 scheduled for consideration at the meeting on 12 May 2015 to a later date.

3. SR 2015/215: The Legal Aid for Crown Court Proceedings (Costs) (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 2015

The Committee noted a written briefing paper from the Department of Justice on the issues discussed at the meeting on 23 April 2015 in relation to SR 2015/215: The Legal

Aid for Crown Court Proceedings (Costs) (Amendment) Rules (Northern Ireland) 2015 which will prescribe the remuneration for solicitors and counsel representing defendants granted criminal legal aid for cases in the Crown Court.

The Committee discussed the issue of exceptionality and views were expressed that this needed to be addressed quickly.

- *Agreed*: The Committee agreed to seek clarification from the Department of Justice regarding the nature of the proposed consultation on addressing the issue of exceptionality and the timescale for its completion.
