After New Clause 143C(1)(b)(vi) insert –

‘() death records and burial records – death records should include miscarriages and still borns, and should include records of where bodies were donated to other institutions for research;

() hospital and GP visits as well as GP visits to the institution/details of medical care provided e.g. prescriptions, vaccines, tests;

() inspections of the institution by the state;

() records of time spent in private/state hospitals or other state or voluntary institutions by mothers and babies;

() a person’s foster care arrangements;

- () a person's medical information;
- () baptism records;
- () parish registry records;
- () personal letters such as notes of communications or diaries kept by mothers;
- () a person's early life as a child within the relevant institution;
- () a person's adoption;
- () monies, fees, or donations paid for the stay of each resident;
- () full personal records including passports, visas for mothers or children;
- () transfer to other institutions including cross-border;
