Mr Ramsey has asked:

To ask the Minister for Employment and Learning which groups in Belfast were offered funding by the European Social Fund for skills and employment training from 2011 to 2014.

ANSWER

A total of 55 projects based in Belfast have been offered funding under Priority 1 of the Northern Ireland Social Fund Programme 2007-2013, to provide employment skills and training over the period 1 April 2011 to 31 March 2014. Of these projects, 38 operate exclusively within Belfast, and 17 deliver activities across Northern Ireland. A further 8 projects based in Belfast have recently been offered funding for the period 1 April 2013 to 31 March 2014. Of these, 5 operate exclusively within Belfast and 3 deliver activities across Northern Ireland. A list of each respective group of projects is attached.
