There are a number of schemes currently open for application across a range of sectors from farming to the environment with over £17million in funding available. These opportunities include the £12million Farm Business Investment Scheme supporting farmers and growers with larger-scale transformational investment in on-farm capital projects. Full details of the current schemes available are provided at the Annex. My Department is also making final preparations for this year's Single Application scheme, with £300million in funding available for Northern Ireland farmers in 2022.
