PARLIAMENTARY CONSTITUENCY PROFILES

This paper contains a selection of maps and tables generated using data provided by Land and Property Services and the Northern Ireland Statistics & Research Agency. It presents a sample of indicators from the wide range available for parliamentary constituencies in Northern Ireland. Section 1 of the paper provides a broad overview at Parliamentary Constituency level (showing the highest 6, middle 6 and lowest 6 constituencies) on 20 different indicators covering population, health, economy, industry, crime, social security and education. Section 2 provides a more detailed ward level analysis (showing wards in the highest 25%, middle 50% and lowest 25% relative to all wards in Northern Ireland), for each constituency, on 7 indicators covering housing, unemployment, poverty, crime, education and life expectancy.

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PARLIAMENTARY CONSTITUENCY PROFILES

Introduction

The following maps and tables were generated by Research & Library Services using data provided by Land and Property Services and the Northern Ireland Statistics & Research Agency (NISRA). They provide a sample of indicators available for parliamentary constituencies in Northern Ireland covering population, housing, health, economy, industry, poverty, crime, social security and education.¹


Parliamentary Constituency Profiles - % of population aged over 60 (June 2007)

Parliamentary Constituency Profiles - death rates due to circulatory disease (2002-2006)








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
Parliamentary Constituency Profiles - admission rates for self harm (2003-2007)

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


