### Peter,

I have had a quick look at the EA and note that the bridge replacement could range over 5-10 years and essential maintenance over 3-7 years from the completion of the renewals project. It would be useful if this scheduling is used to derive options 3a) and 3b) or, at the very least, a suitable explanation is provided as to why this scheduling has not been taken forward.

Furthermore, the EA would need to be clear about the assumptions behind the estimate of £4.3M given it is substantially higher than that shown within the EA.

Over and above the three options in the appraisal, I believe there are 3 more:

- 1. A maintenance option without the passing loop and the new signaling this option is rejected at the long list stage because it will not deliver the benefits of the new trains programme
- 2. Option 3(a) which is option 3, but with the bridge works deferred for 5 years.
- 3. Option 4(a) which is option 4, but with the bridge works deferred for 5 years.

Options 3(a) and 4(a) will have upfront costs reduced by the bridge costs (£4.3m from David's e-mail); however in year 5 we have to add the £4.3m costs back plus the costs of uprooting the track, bus subs etc.
