Over 500 of our members are in Northern Ireland, many of whom are actively involved in planning across a wide range of sectors throughout Northern Ireland.

The RTPI NI is in support of the proposal to permit information sharing for the purposes of identifying owners of empty homes. Northern Ireland, along with other regions of the UK, is currently facing a serious and complex housing crisis of which

there is no single solution. The cumulative impact of empty properties on the rolling					
housing supply in Northern Ireland could be substantial, it is therefore extremely					
important that local authorities and or the Department of Social Development are					
aware of the details of such properties that are potentially restricting much needed					
housing supply.
