The meeting commenced in open session at 10.03 a.m.

1. Apologies

Apologies were noted as above.

2. Draft Minutes

Members were reminded that an informal meeting has been scheduled with RICS in Parliament Buildings at 9.30 on 7 October 2015. Members were asked to indicate their availability to attend this meeting as it was agreed by the Committee on 3 September 2015 that it could be a useful pre-cursor to the proposed departmental update on the review of the role and regulation of the private rented sector in December.

Members noted that the Clerk will present proposed housing issues for inclusion in the Committee's Forward Work Programme at the Committee meeting of 1 October 2015. The proposals will be based on the Committee's strategic planning discussions and the meeting between the Chair and the Chief Executive of the NIHE on 17 September 2015.

Members noted that Supporting Communities NI is holding its annual conference at the Tullyglass Hotel, Ballymena on Thursday 22 October 2015 to highlight their work in relation to Community Participation.
