Good afternoon, Paula. Thank you for your kind words. Further to our meeting with the Committee for the Executive Office please find the list of the Baby Homes. These institutions were included in the Queens Report of January 2021 but subsequently were removed. These establishments were a clear route for moving babies from place to place. This includes from Private Homes as well as Institutions St Joseph's Baby Home Belfast Nazareth Portadown Connywarren Omagh Fahan Donegal As we said in the Committee Meeting many cases outside of the Institutions must be looked at in a case by case basis. Adoptees are coming forward with the facts that they were born to a woman in a Private Nursing Home and moved immediately to a Baby Home eg: St Joseph's Baby Home. We were asked about the Birth Fathers role in this Inquiry and this has been discussed and dismissed at Forum level. The majority of Birth Mothers were abandoned and many of the pregnancies were a result of rape or incest. Yes there were Birth Fathers who were denied a say in the future of their child but these are in the minority. The inclusion of Birth Fathers in this process is a compete anathema to many Birth Mothers.

I have to ask the question why are there two round table events in Co Tyrone.
