It was witnessed a few months ago a young woman being brought to the door of one of these clinics, by her male companion, she clearly did not want to go in and was crying, she walked around the side of the building and was handed pro-life literature which she took, she was not forced to take it. But she obviously was being forced into ending her baby's life by her unsupportive partner. This is the type of woman who need us and other pro-life groups like us to be there, in support, love and compassion, please don't remove this opportunity.
