COM/2022/748 Proposal for a Regulation on classification, labelling and packaging of substances and mixtures

At its meeting on 24 October 2024, the Windsor Framework Democratic Scrutiny Committee (DSC) considered the above-named [proposed EU Regulation](#). The DSC is gathering evidence on the proposed act to put it in a more informed position when it is notified that the act has been published.

The DSC agreed that I write to you to request that an updated Explanatory Memorandum be shared with it as soon as possible. Specifically, the Committee requests details of:

- The steps the UK Government (UKG) has taken to mitigate divergence in this area;
- UKG's engagement with the EU on the proposed act through the Windsor Framework structures;
- UKG's discussions through the Common Framework, and engagement with Northern Ireland departments and stakeholders;
- The views of the other devolved administrations; and,
- UKG's policy intentions in this area.

I would appreciate a response by 8 November 2024.
