**COM/2023/462 Proposal for a Regulation on the safety of toys and
repealing Directive 2009/48/EC**

At its meeting on 1 May 2025, the Windsor Framework Democratic Scrutiny Committee (DSC) agreed to seek views from stakeholders on the above proposed replacement EU act once the draft text, which was provisionally agreed by the European Parliament and Council of the EU on 10 April 2025, became publicly available.

This text will need to be formally adopted by the European Parliament and Council of the EU before it is published in the Official Journal of the EU. The DSC is gathering views to put it in a more informed position when the published act is notified to it by Cabinet Office. [Read more about the Committee process here](#).

Specifically, the DSC is seeking your views on whether applying/not applying the act would have a significant negative impact specific to everyday life of communities in Northern Ireland in a way that is liable to persist.
