COM/2022/748 Proposal for a Regulation on classification, labelling and packaging of substances and mixtures

At its meeting on 24 October 2024, the Windsor Framework Democratic Scrutiny Committee (DSC) considered the above-named proposed EU act.

Information on the purpose and functions of the DSC can be found here.

One of the statutory functions of the DSC is to examine and consider replacement EU acts. In carrying out this function, the DSC assesses whether the application of an act "would have a significant impact specific to everyday life of communities in Northern Ireland in a way that is liable to persist".

To help inform the DSC's assessment of the proposed EU act, the Committee agreed that I write to you to request information on the scale of trade between Great Britain and Northern Ireland in the chemicals sector.
