

PART INPUT TO TEO - Regulation (EU) 2024/3110 construction products

Department for Infrastructure (DfI) input in relation to construction products for roads and bridges.

- DfI uses a UK wide, Manual of Contract Documents for Highway Works for Roads and Bridges, for all aspects of specification of products. The Manual is used for the preparation of construction contracts to deliver consistent quality assured products into the roads market and continues to apply certain EU rules in relation to construction products for DfI.
- DfI does not have any expertise, lead role or function in the implementation or enforcement of this new Regulation.
- An Explanatory Memorandum has not currently been received and it is not possible to evaluate the impact of the new Regulation, according to the democratic scrutiny structures. It would be reasonable to assume that the British Government's reform of the systems relating to construction products would align, to some extent, with the EU's approach.
- The placing and making available on the market of construction products is a reserved matter, with decisions taken by the Secretary of State for the Ministry of Housing, Communities & Local Government.
- The new Regulation is not expected to have a significant bearing on the availability or performance of products regularly specified by DfI.
