1 Apologies

1.1 Apologies were received from Kellie Armstrong and John Stewart.

2 <u>Minutes of previous meetings</u>

2.1 The minutes of the meeting on 17 November were **agreed**.

3 Matters Arising

- 3.1 Members **noted** that they had agreed to review the dates for Christmas recess once the Executive had provided information on its legislative programme.
- 3.2 Members **noted** that the requested information had not yet been received from the Executive but that it was necessary to confirm dates at this meeting.
- 3.3 Members **noted** a paper with three different options for Christmas recess provided in their packs.
- 3.4 The Clerk of Business summarised the content of the paper, outlining the advantages and disadvantages of three potential options and how they related to previous practice, for Members' consideration.
- 3.5 Members **agreed** to select option 1, that recess would remain as originally agreed with the understanding that recall arrangements could be utilised at any time during the recess period if needed, and if issues arose in relation to coronavirus, the Ad Hoc Committee could be convened.
- 3.6 Members **noted** that an APN would issue later that day to communicate this decision.
- 3.7 There were no other matters arising.

4 <u>Finalisation of the Order Papers for the Plenary Meetings in Week</u> <u>Commencing 30 November 2020</u>

Monday 30 November

- 4.1 Members **noted** that a statutory rule from the Minister of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs, which the Executive had previously scheduled for this date, had now been removed.
- 4.2 Members **noted** that otherwise business remained as agreed at last week's meeting with the addition of the following items of Executive business:

- i. The Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions) (No. 2) (Amendment No. 11) Regulations (NI) 2020.
- ii. The Health Protection (Coronavirus, Restrictions) (No. 2) (Amendment No. 12) Regulations (NI) 2020.

- iii. The Health Protection (Coronavirus, Wearing of Face Coverings) (Amendment No. 3) Regulations (NI) 2020.
- 4.3 Members **agreed** to schedule a single untimed debate for all three motions.
- 4.4 A Member raised concerns that the previous week, a debate on legislation had continued until 2.15am and suggested that although the debate was long, this did not necessarily increase participation as some Members were excluded from late sittings due to caring responsibilities. He requested that the Committee considers introducing time limits on individual contributions.
- 4.5 The Speaker noted that a related piece of work had commenced previously which he would revisit. The Speaker **agreed** to consider the proposal and to return to it at a future meeting.

Private Members' Business

- 4.6 Members **agreed** not to schedule Private Members' motions.
- 4.7 Members **agreed** the Order Paper for Monday 30 November.
- 4.8 A Member suggested that the Committee reintroduces a restriction on Private Members' business in response to the recently announced coronavirus restrictions.
- 4.9 The Speaker noted that by scheduling Private Members' business the week before a sitting, the Committee is making the best use of plenary time.

Tuesday 1 December

Executive Committee Business

4.10 Members **noted** that there had been no changes to the Executive Business agreed at the last meeting.

Private Members' Business

- 4.11 Members **agreed** to schedule a Private Members' motion.
- 4.12 The following Private Members' motion was selected with the usual timings:
 - Preparations for a COVID-19 Vaccine (DUP)
- 4.13 The junior Minister indicated that a Minister would be available to respond.

- 4.14 Members **agreed** not to schedule an adjournment debate.
- 4.15 Members **agreed** the Order Paper for Tuesday 1 December.

 - The Administration of Estates (Small Payments) (Increase of Limit) (NI) Order for the Minister of Finance, which was also yet to be confirmed.

 - The Plant Health and Diseases of Animals (Amendment) (EU Exit) Regulations (NI) 2020
- 5.8 Members **agreed** to schedule untimed debates for both SRs.
- 5.9 Members **agreed** to schedule a motion for the Committee for the Economy on its Macro Economic Micro Inquiry, with 1.5 hours for the debate to include 10 minutes for moving and winding, 15 minutes for a Ministerial response and 5 minutes for all other speakers.

- 5.11 Members **agreed** to defer taking a decision on an adjournment debate until the next meeting.
