School Uniforms (Trousers) Bill: potential stakeholder list

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1 Introduction

This Briefing Note has been prepared to inform the planning of the Ad Hoc Committee for the consideration of the School Uniforms (Trousers) Bill. It comprises a list of potential representative bodies and organisations, as well other stakeholders in Northern Ireland, to inform Committee deliberations on who it wishes to consult when scrutinising the School Uniforms (Trousers) Bill, introduced 22 June 2026.

The list is informed by consideration of relevant literature on gendered uniforms; review of the [Northern Ireland Assembly Commission Equality Scheme 2022 - 2026 consultees](#); and consideration of responses to previous relevant consultations including the Department of Education's [consultation on a proposed School Uniform Bill](#), the Committee for Education's scrutiny of the [School Uniforms \(Guidelines and Allowances\) Bill](#) (now Act), and Committee for Education's stakeholder engagements during its planning of the School Uniforms (Trousers) Bill. It should be noted that the list does not comprise all organisations who responded to DE's consultation or the Committee's prior engagements. Some of the listed organisations may have previously provided feedback to consultation/calls for evidence, but on an anonymous basis.
