The Schools (Part-Time 20mph Speed Limit) (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2026

Made - - - - - *29th April 2026*

Coming into operation *20th May 2026*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a), makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 38(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

In accordance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 5 to the 1997 Order, the Department has consulted such persons as it considers appropriate.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Schools (Part-Time 20mph Speed Limit) (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2026 and shall come into operation on 20th May 2026.

Amendment

2.—(1) Schedule 1 to The Schools (Part-Time 20mph Speed Limit) Order (Northern Ireland) 2018^(d) is amended in accordance with paragraph (2).

(2) After item no. 310 insert the following—

- “311. Castlegore Road, Route B72, Castleberg – from a point 106 metres north-east of its junction with Dergvale, Route U4501, for a distance of 293 metres in a north-easterly direction.
- 312. Drumquin Road, Route B50, Castleberg – from its junction with Castlegore Road, Route B72, for a distance of 164.50 metres in a south-easterly direction.

313. Trienamongan Road, Route U0168, Castleberg – from a point 218 metres north-east of its junction with Corgary Road, Route C0675, for a distance of 322 metres in a north-easterly direction.
314. Cloughcor Road, Route U1821, Cloughcor – from a point 258 metres east of its junction with Victoria Road, Route A5, for a distance of 227 metres in an easterly direction.
315. Breen Park, Route U4740, Victoria Bridge – from its junction with Fyfin Road, Route B72, for a distance of 5 metres in a north-westerly direction.
316. Fyfin Road, Route B72, Victoria Bridge – from a point 73 metres south-west of its junction with Breenvale, Route U4740, for a distance of 229 metres in a north-easterly direction.
317. Urbalreagh Road, Route C0672, Victoria Bridge – from its junction with Fyfin Road, Route B72, for a distance of 18 metres in a south-westerly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Schools (Part-Time 20mph Speed Limit) Order (Northern Ireland) 2018 (“the 2018 Order”) by the introduction of part-time speed limits on a length of—

1. Castlegore Road and Drumquin Road, Castleberg adjacent to Castleberg High School;
2. Trienamongan Road, Castleberg adjacent to St Caireall’s Primary School;
3. Cloughcor Road, Cloughcor adjacent to St Mary’s Primary School; and
4. Breen Park, Fyfin Road and Urbalreagh Road, Victoria Bridge, adjacent to St. Eugene’s Primary School.

The Order permits the current speed limit on these lengths of road to be reduced to 20 miles per hour when a 20 miles per hour limit is indicated by a traffic sign.
