**The Waiting Restrictions (Comber) (Amendment No. 2) Order
(Northern Ireland) 2026**

Made - - - - - *21st May 2026*

Coming into operation - *11th June 2026*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) (“the 1997 Order”) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with Article 4(6) of, and paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to, the 1997 Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Waiting Restrictions (Comber) (Amendment No. 2) Order (Northern Ireland) 2026 and shall come into operation on 11th June 2026.

Amendment

2.—(1) The Waiting Restrictions (Comber) Order (Northern Ireland) 2018^(d) is amended in accordance with paragraph (2).

(2) In Schedule 2 after item 3 add the following item—

“4. A22, Killinchy Road (both sides) – from a point 40 metres north of its junction with Carnesure Park for a distance of 20 metres in a northerly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Waiting Restrictions (Comber) Order (Northern Ireland) 2018 (“the 2018 Order”) by the addition of a no waiting at any time restriction (loading and unloading not permitted) on the lengths of road specified in Article 2.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the 2018 Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and the Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of this Order will in due course be placed on the road.
