Electric Vehicle Charge Points

During Assembly Commission question time on Tuesday 15 June 2021, you asked if the Assembly Commission could consider extending the number of electric vehicle charge points across the Stormont Estate, and I can confirm that the matter was raised at the Assembly Commission meeting on 8 July 2021.

The Assembly Commission has responsibility for Parliament Buildings and its immediate environs. Beyond that, responsibility sits with the Department of Finance and specifically the Stormont Estate Management Unit (SEMU).

I can however advise, that the Assembly Commission has received confirmation from the Finance Minister, that his Department continues to support the emerging market for plug in electric vehicles by providing charging points across the Estate. To this end, alongside the 4 charging points that are available at Parliament Buildings, there are currently 1 single headed and 3 double headed charging points across the Estate.

In addition to this, the Assembly's Secretariat Management Group have already agreed an action in the Assembly Commission's Environmental Continuous Improvement Plan for 2021-22 to liaise with colleagues in SEMU to assess the feasibility of providing further electric vehicle charging points in the Lower East car park.

I hope this is helpful.
