Re: Review of the Sale of the National Asset Management Agency (NAMA) property loan portfolio in Northern Ireland

I acknowledge receipt of your letter dated March 2nd inviting me to attend the Committee to 'respond to issues arising from the (Spotlight) programme.' I must decline for the following reason;

As a former employee of NAMA I have a statutory obligation of confidentiality in respect of my work in connection with the Agency.

Your correspondence specifically refers to the BBC (NI) Spotlight programme broadcast on Monday, 29th February 2016. I cannot comment on the apparent reference to me by those covertly recorded at a meeting in the Malmaison Hotel, Belfast.

I wish to point out, however, that, as has already been publicly stated by NAMA, all decision-making in the Agency was subject to a Board-approved delegated matrix. As a result, no individual could make a decision regarding enforcement or otherwise of a debt. Any suggestion to the contrary is a misrepresentation of the decision-making process invariably followed.
