Amendment of the Civil Service (Special Advisers) Act (Northern Ireland) 2013

- **1.**—(1) The Civil Service (Special Advisers) Act (Northern Ireland) 2013 is amended as follows.
- (2) In section 7 (Code of Conduct), after subsection (3) insert—
 "(3A) Without prejudice to the generality of subsection (1), the code must provide that special advisers are subject to the processes and procedures of the disciplinary code operative in the Northern Ireland Civil Service and, for the avoidance of doubt, that there can be no ministerial involvement or interference".
 - (3) In section 8 (Code for appointments), after subsection (3)(b), insert—
 "(c) must not be remunerated above the rate within the Senior Civil
 Service Pay Structure applicable to Assistant Secretary (Grade 5)".

Amendment of the Civil Service Commissioners (Northern Ireland) Order 1999

- **2.**—(1) The Civil Service Commissioners (Northern Ireland) Order 1999 is amended as follows.
- (2) In Article 3 (Selection on merit), in paragraph (4) the words "up to three persons" shall be replaced with the words "one person".
