### TREASURY FUNDING AVAILABLE 2026-29/30

*Published on Wednesday 25 March 2026*

**Mr John O'Dowd (The Minister of Finance):** The purpose of this Statement is to inform the Assembly of the updated funding made available by the Treasury for the Budget 2026-29/30 as notified by the Secretary of State for Northern Ireland following the Spring Statement.

In accordance with my statutory duty under Section 64 of the Northern Ireland Act 1998, I am required to lay before the Assembly a Statement detailing the UK funding provided for 2026-29/30 at least 14 days prior to laying a draft Budget.

The funding that will be provided to the Executive for the period 2026-29/30, is set out below.
