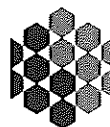

Dear Speaker

You will recall that, on 14 October 2014 in the Assembly, I answered Topical Question AQT 1616/11-15 from Alastair Ross MLA, on the "Speak Up, Save a Life" organ donation campaign.

In that answer, I stated:

"Before the campaign started, there had been 20,826 new registrants on the organ donor register".

However, the factual position is as follows:

"Between the start of the campaign and 10 October 2014, there have been 20,826 new registrants on the organ donor register".

I apologise for this discrepancy, and am copying this letter to all MLAs and the Assembly Library Services for their information.
