
Mr M Nesbitt (Strangford): To ask the First Minister and deputy First Minister to detail (i) the community and voluntary groups in South Belfast that were awarded funding by their Department, or its arm's-length bodies, in each month of the last two years; (ii) the date that funding was awarded; (iii) who awarded the funding; (iv) the method by which funding was paid; (v) the amount of funding awarded in each case; and (vi) who was involved in any presentations.

ANSWER

The table below summarises the funds paid to community and voluntary groups in the South Belfast parliamentary constituency by OFMDFM either directly or via its arm's length bodies. The information is available on the basis of financial years and is not available on a monthly breakdown. All funds were paid via electronic bank transfer and no ceremonial presentations were made. A table detailing a full breakdown of funds awarded has been placed in the Assembly Library.
