In the course of Topical Question Time on 16 February 2016 I committed to provide you with information regarding the level of economic inactivity in North Belfast.

Official estimates of economic inactivity are sourced from the Labour Force Survey (LFS) in line with international standards. Table 1 provides estimates of economic inactivity rates for North Belfast from 2010 to 2014.
