**Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2021/260 of 11 February 2021 approving national measures designed to limit the impact of certain diseases of aquatic animals in accordance with Article 226(3) of Regulation (EU) 2016/429 of the European Parliament and of the Council and repealing Commission Decision 2010/221/EU.**

In addition to those diseases listed above, this Decision approves the national measures which have been adopted by Northern Ireland in order to limit the impact of the following diseases affecting aquatic animals, in accordance with Article 226(3) of Regulation (EU) 2016/429:

Spring viraemia of carp (SVC)

Bacterial kidney disease (BKD)

*Gyrodactylus salaris* (GS)
