I have sought the requested information from the Chief Executive, who has advised me as follows:

"The Housing Executive does not hold the information in the format requested. Whilst NIHE's current complaints management system can provide the number of repair- and maintenance-related formal complaints received, it does not currently allow NIHE to report on the specific detail you have requested. On this basis, NIHE has provided the below information which they trust you will find satisfactory.

- We currently don't hold specific information on individual cases of 'black mould' within our records as reports are not categorised in this way.
- Table 1 details the number of damp-related reports received by the Housing Executive in each of the last five years, broken down by local council area. The following table figures represent:
