Follow up action to AQO 1351/22-27 raised at Question Time 14<sup>th</sup> January 2025 – distribution of Arts Council funding.

On 14<sup>th</sup> January 2025, in a follow up question to AQO 1351/22-27, you asked " Is the Minister aware of the percentage of Arts Council funding that goes to the Belfast City Council area compared with other areas?"

I have recently received funding figures for both Exchequer and National Lottery funding provided by the Arts Council of Northern Ireland. I have attached these at Annex A.

Funding for the arts across Northern Ireland must be equitable. The needs of those in rural and urban areas are equally important; whether they are creative practitioners, seeking a career in the arts and creative industries, or experiencing the arts in their daily lives.



Belfast is the largest conurbation in Northern Ireland and is the postcode base for many organisations whose artistic footprint reaches beyond the council boundaries. So, at face value, it is understandable that it appears that Belfast is favoured.

There is work to be done to better understand the way funding is distributed. My officials are currently examining this as part of the development of the new arts policy.
