UPDATE ON VILLAGE CATALYST GRANT SCHEME

At Assembly Question Time on February 10, you asked me for an update on my Department's £110,000 scheme to explore regeneration projects in 10 rural villages, as announced in a 2023 Press Release. The scheme referred to is the Village Catalyst Grant Scheme. I promised to write to you outlining its progress.

The department administers the Village Catalyst Grant Scheme (VGCS) in partnership with the Architectural Heritage Fund, DAERA and NIHE. The scheme is a three-stage fund: viability and development grants (funded by the department and issued by the Architectural Heritage Fund) support communities to develop proposals. Ultimately, delivery grants are then provided for site works and are provided by the department from its own funds and from significantly larger funds provided by DAERA. NIHE has also committed to support this, subject to available budgets. Overall, the fund supports communities to take on heritage at risk in villages and provide sustainable uses that tackle rural poverty and social isolation.

I attach a table at Annex A providing an update on each of the projects mentioned in that press release. It reflects the development of a pipeline of projects, one of which is now on-site and many of which are increasingly prepared for their own delivery phase. You may be glad to learn, in addition, that 15 villages are currently being supported to progress projects through this scheme.
