Engaged Communities Group – Small Capital grants

Between 2016 and 2022 the Department ran the Small Capital Grants programme, providing grants of up to £5,000 via an Intermediary funding body to support organisations in the voluntary and community sector.

In this period, funding was distributed to 534 sporting organisations for projects totalling £1,677,018. We do not keep records detailing each individual grant, however the funding was intended for the purchase of items such as IT equipment, sporting equipment, catering equipment and material, with minor capital works to improve premises also eligible.
