This issue is an operational matter for the Housing Executive.

I have sought the requested information from the Chief Executive, who has advised me as follows:

*'In terms of accessible homes, the Common Waiting List includes an indicator for ground floor or wheelchair accessible housing. The waiting list and allocations figures as at end March for the 5-year period 2021-2025, and latest available dataset June 2025, for Strangford and South Belfast / Strangford PCs, for those requiring ground floor accommodation and those who are wheelchair users are:*
